



Labour's spokesperson Catherine King called on Julie Bishop to send military support to Ebola affected countries. Australian army medics are trained to cope with germ warfare.







Each day, new patients arrive at treatment centers, hoping their timing and symptoms will get them past the gate.

The number of reported Ebola cases is doubling roughly every five weeks in Sierra Leone. But in as little as two to three weeks in Liberia. The number of reported cases globally is projected to reach 10,000 by the end of October. The actual number of cases may be twice the official figure.




The massive die off of bees in the USA. Obama should take action to save the remaining bees by banning the use of neonicotinoid pesticides.

Deaths by type of road user and ranked by pedestrian road user




The economic recession since mid 2009 reduced road fatalities.


Perhaps due to increased fuel prices, less recreational driving, less truck traffic.

Asia Pacific Region road traffic deaths 100,000 population




Double trouble as El Niño's western cousin grows stronger in 2014


New Zealand Drought Index 1941-2013



US Secretary of State, John Kerry, currently on a visit to India:




The report also showed men were more likely to die by suicide than women. In the developed countries they were three times more likely to die at their own hands.




There were hopeful signs about the longer term. CO₂ emissions fell by about 12% in both USA and EU between 2007 and 2012. The reasons included the global recession, rising gas use and a shift to renewable energy sources.

Last month was the hottest May in terms of global surface temperature in a historical record that extends back 130 years. According to NASA, and with an El Niño forecast for the end of the year, we could see more records fall. President Obama's recent announcement of pollution controls on coal-fired power generation is also an important step.
